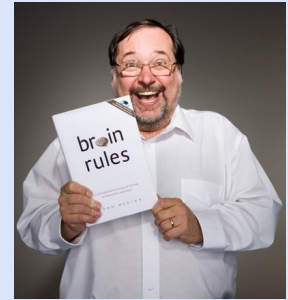
John Medina

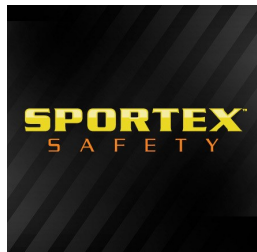

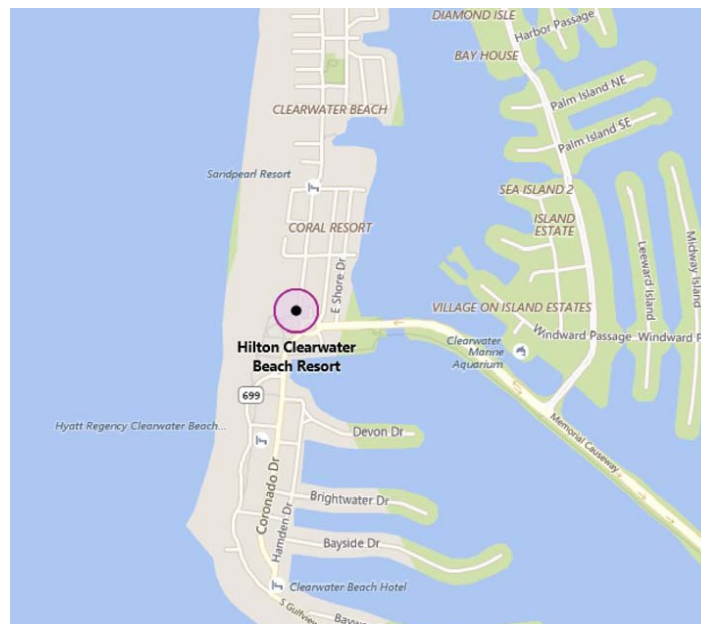
