The One Sarasota Tower (Sarasota, FL), a 12-story, 142,000-square-foot commercial office building, has made monumental leaps in the energy efficiency world. In less than two years, One Sarasota Tower is now in the final stages of qualifying as an ENERGY STAR certified building, a designation which indicates the facility performs better than at least 75 percent of similar buildings nationwide. The partnership between mechanical services contractor and GreenSTAR Hill York (Fort Lauderdale, FL), and One Sarasota's management team, ICORR Properties International, has been instrumental in boos ting the building's ENERGY STAR score from 36 to 82, a 144 percent increase. Rob Pulsifer, Director of Energy Service at Hill York, says, "It was very much a co-
